- Confidence building: Performing music nurtures self-esteem and public speaking skills.

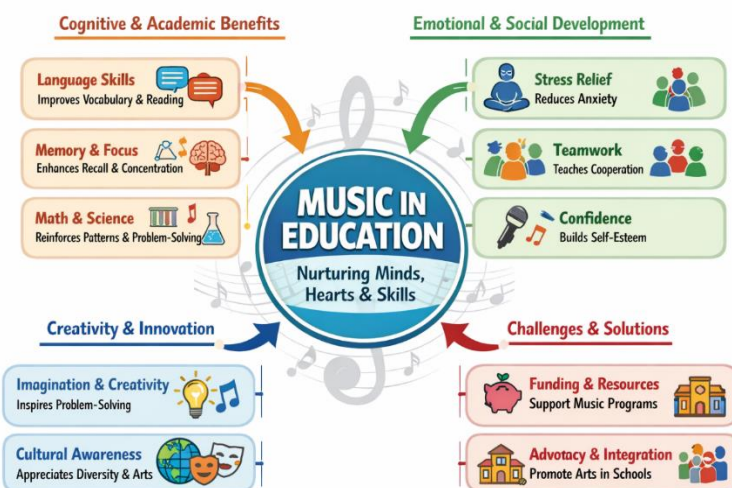
3. Social & Cultural Impact
